**Four Simple Steps to Nominate for GAEA/NAEA Awards**

**1. Select a nominee within one of these categories:**

- Georgia Art Educator of the Year
- Elementary Art Educator of the Year
- Middle Level Art Educator of the Year
- Secondary Art Educator of the Year
- Higher Education Art Educator of the Year
- Supervision/Administration Art Educator of the Year
- Museum Education Art Educator of the Year
- Croy West Special Needs Art Educator of the Year
- Distinguished Service Within the Profession Award
- Distinguished Service Outside the Profession Award
- Retired Art Educator Award
- Higher Education Student Achievement Award (for college or university students who are members of GAEA/NAEA)
- Student Chapter Sponsor Award of Excellence (Sponsorship of an outstanding Student Chapter at the College/University Level)
- Outstanding National Art Honor Society Sponsor Award
- Outstanding Junior National Art Honor Society Sponsor Award (middle school level)
- Rising Stars Secondary Recognition Program (for NAHS student member with goal of art education as a career)

- Charles M. Robertson Memorial Scholarship (For NAHS high school seniors who wish to major in Art Education, this is a four-year partial scholarship to Pratt Institute of Art and Design in Brooklyn, NY.)

- Committee on Multiethnic Concerns J. Eugene Grigsby, Jr. Award
